



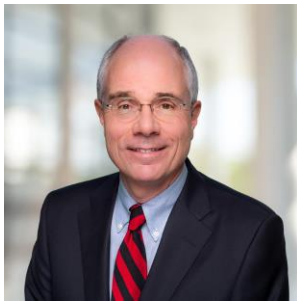
## Board Member Bios, 2026 Pittock Mansion Board of Directors
